#2 – as I mentioned yesterday, Jason, Pete Loiodice and Marvin Martinez were in the Emergency Command Center. One of the police down at the parade location called over the radio saying "there is a group with Palestinian flags" (no mention of signs according to Jason) to which Peter responded to send them to the protest area. Apparently the police then saw them heading to the line up area where they stated they were part of the parade. Jason looked the group up on the computer and verified that Peace Action Montgomery was indeed scheduled to be in the parade. He then looked at their website and thought it looked legitimate and not necessarily politically charged. The camera view from the ECC is a rear shot at the beginning of the parade so they could not see the messages on the signs from their vantage point.

Peace Action has marched in the parade for many years with the same approach. We even won 2 awards.
